3. THE PRESS, TELEVISION TALK SHOWS, AND RADIO COMMENTARIES ALL HOTLY DEBATED PROSPECTIVE U.S. MILITARY ACTION. WHILE MANY OBSERVERS AGREED THAT QADHAFI HAS TO BE RECKONED WITH IN SOME WAY, MOST FELT MILITARY MOVES WOULD BE PROVOCATIVE AND COUNTERPRODUCTIVE, NOT TO MENTION DANGEROUS FOR BRITONS AND OTHER EUROPEANS IN THE MEDITERRANEAN REGION. THATCHER WAS BROADLY PRAISED BY OPPOSITION POLITICIANS AND OTHERS FOR ALLEGEDLY SAYING NO TO THE REPORTED AMERICAN REQUEST AND FOR URGING CAUTION UPON THE ADMINISTRATION. HOWEVER, THE MOST RESPECTED PAPERS (PRESUMABLY AFTER CHECKING WITH NUMBER 10 OR THE FCO) WERE CAREFUL NOT TO IMPLY THAT THATCHER HAD ADVISED THE USG AGAINST ANY MILITARY ACTION AT ALL.

4. ACTION REQUESTED: WE HAVE HELD TO A VERY SPARSE PRESS LINE SINCE THE WALTERS VISIT, MERELY ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THE VISIT TOOK PLACE AND REFUSING TO CHARACTERIZE THE THATCHER MEETING BEYOND SAYING WE DISCUSSED MATTERS OF MUTUAL INTEREST. MORE NUANCED GUIDANCE WOULD BE HELPFUL TO US (AND OTHER POSTS) AS WE HEAD INTO WHAT IS BOUND TO BE A RELENTLESS WEEK ON THE PRESS SIDE.

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
