Jean Seveling - General,

By the time you receive this message, you will probably already have heard this morning's announcement from 10 Downing Street of my decision to make way for a successor, and to resign as Prime Minister as soon as the Parliamentary Party has completed the necessary procedures for electing a new leader. I shall of course remain in charge of the Government until my successor has been appointed.

I should like to thank you for the great co-operation and friendship which you have always shown me. My admiration for your strength of purpose and commitment to the highest standards in international relations knows no bounds. I am sad that we shall no longer be able to work together on finding solutions to the problems facing the United Nations. But you will always have my fullest confidence and trust, and I send you my warmest gratitude and good wishes.
